

1. POPULATION

Since its beginning in 1790, the decennial census has provided the only data that count and describe all individuals and households in the United States. Details of age, race, income, education, ancestry, language, family and household characteristics, employment, etc., are available from the 2000 Census for areas as small as a group of city blocks.

In addition to describing how we live and providing for reapportionment, decennial census data also provide benchmarks for intercensal population estimates and numerous other data series. Population estimates for Tennessee and its counties are reported annually. These are produced by the Bureau of the Census in cooperation with the UT Center for Business and Economic Research and published on the Internet <<http://www.census.gov/population>>.

County population estimates also provide the means to estimate the population of Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA). Such areas are aggregates of whole counties. Although changes to MSA boundaries are planned, tables in this *Abstract* and 2000 Census data describe the MSAs as designated by the Office of Management and Budget, effective June 30, 1996. These MSA boundaries are shown in Figure 0.1. When time series MSA data are used, one should determine whether the geographic areas are consistent. Table 1.7 provides comparable population data for these areas from 1950 to 2000, using the June 1996 definition.

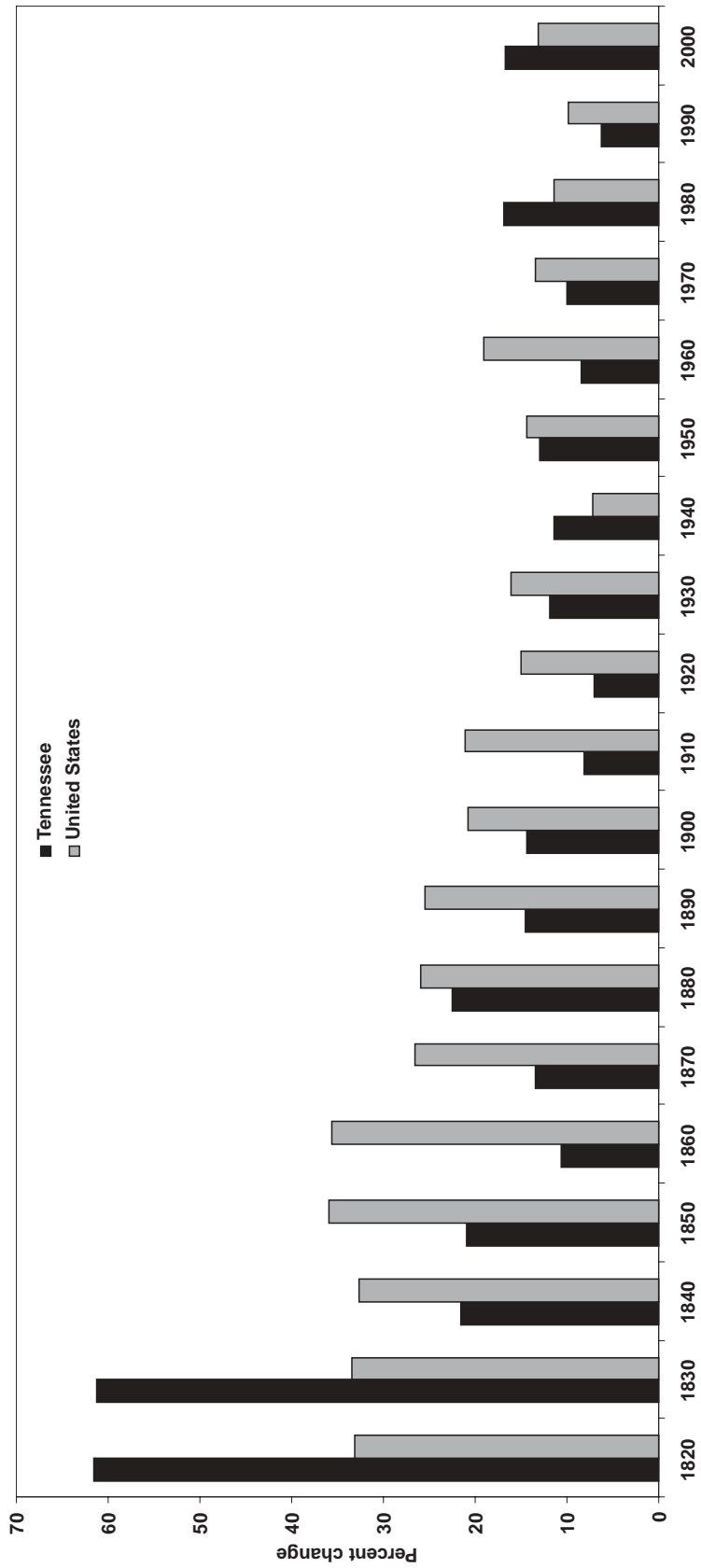

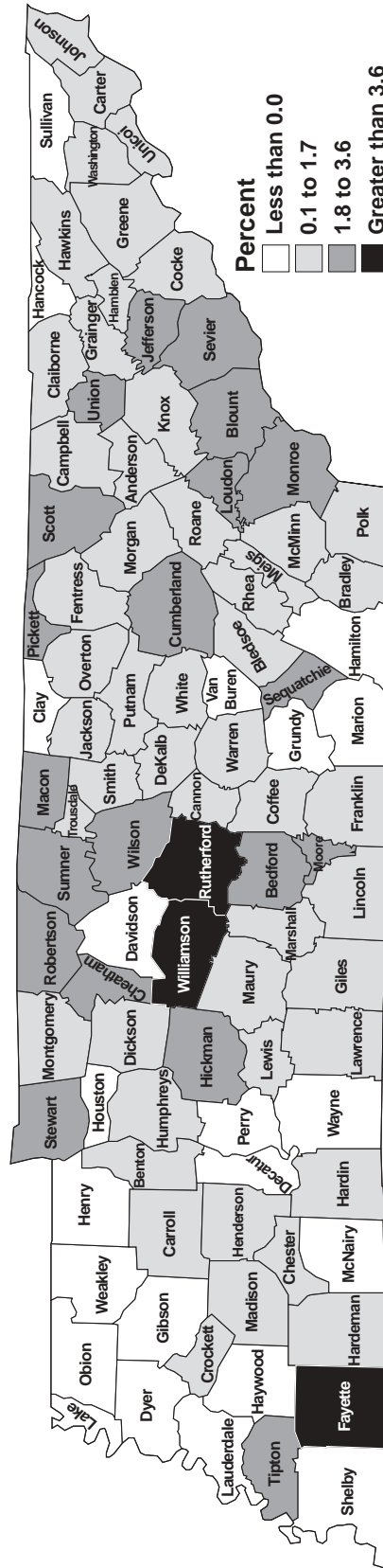
